## **Additional Renewal Information**

- Full-time enrollment is required each semester.
- All scholarship recipients can utilize the subsequent Summer term following the Fall/Spring semesters to keep eligibility.
- Excluding the HOPE Scholarship, all scholarships are for four years from their initial college enrollment.
- Scholarships will be terminated when the student completes the requirements for their first undergraduate degree.
- The LIFE Scholarship is the only scholarship for which a student can gain or regain eligibility. To do so, a student needs to meet the renewal criteria and the general requirements, such as being a SC Resident.
