For LIFE Scholarship, SC HOPE Scholarship
Deadline: March 1

Students who complete all requirements for high school graduation prior to the official graduation date in May/June may be eligible to receive the LIFE Scholarship, or SC HOPE. Please refer to the Scholarship guidelines posted on the Commission on Higher Education's (CHE) website at www.che.sc.gov.

Early Graduation Documents

In order to be considered for Early Graduation, the following **must** be submitted to the financial aid office at the higher education institution by the deadline date:

1. Original and completed Early Graduation Application signed by student (Part I);
2. Institution Section (Part II) completed by a financial aid representative at the institution;
3. Original principal letter (on school letterhead) indicating student **has completed** all high school requirements by the established December/January deadline;
4. Original high school transcript(s) must be in an officially sealed envelope. Transcript must include all grades through December/January and include a cumulative GPA based on the SC Uniform Grading Policy;
5. All documents must be received by the institution's financial aid office no later than 5:00 pm on **March 1**.
6. **Incomplete documents and files by the deadline date will not be considered.**

**IT IS THE STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT ALL DOCUMENTS ARE RECEIVED BY MARCH 1.
 INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS BY THE DEADLINE DATE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
